Dear Friends,

We are in good heart at Cornhill Scotland, and enjoying our summer vacation as we prepare for the start of term in September.

We much value your ongoing support in prayer. Here are a few pointers, if I may:

**Students for 2011-12** We have fourteen students returning for their second year in September, and it looks as though we will have between twelve and fourteen new students joining us for the new term. We are much encouraged that numbers are holding up well, and ask you to pray for the few whose applications we are still dealing with.

We are glad to see the growing trend in churches setting up **ministry apprenticeship schemes**, whereby an apprentice does the Cornhill course over two years while at the same time gaining very valuable experience in Christian ministry in an evangelical church. **Charlotte Chapel** in Edinburgh, **St. Catherine's Argyle** (also Edinburgh), and **St. George's-Tron** in Glasgow all now have apprenticeship schemes up and running - and other churches are thinking about similar schemes.

**Servants of the Word Conference, June 2011** We had another very good conference this year with about sixty attending, and we plan to continue with this programme in years to come. We are also thinking of starting up a **Cornhill Summer School** to run for the first time in June 2012. Cornhill London have done this for a number of years now, and it's a good 'shop window' for the course.

**The new Pastors' Training Course**, run by Cornhill Scotland, is due to open this September. We covet your prayers for this new venture. Students are beginning to book in, and **Andy Gemmill** is taking the lead in organizing and setting it up. We pray that it will grow into something really useful for Scotland.

**Staff** **Andy Gemmill** will be with us full-time from September - do pray for him and Annie as they move from Nottingham to Glasgow. **Bob Fyall** is very well again after his difficult period of treatment earlier this year. And I too am very well, and as glad as ever to be able to continue with the work.
